## MBA

# Teaching Methodology, the Core Differentiator

KFA Business School is on a progressive path to have innovative methods of teaching incorporated in its teaching methodology. In this connection, in parallel with the academic course the students are also given exposure to the managerial soft skill development courses (MSMs) and are also persuaded to self realize the intuitive entrepreneurship within to start real life business ventures.

## MSMs

There are several months allocated for different soft skills like Leadership Quality, Communication Skill, Stress Management and Team Building. Expert trainers are brought in to take classes on these topics and assignments are given to the students for which they need to give presentations in front of a panel of judges representing the experts from various fields.

## PEGs

This is an initiative taken by the School to create entrepreneurship in the country. The students are given a week's deadline to decide amongst themselves to choose any SME Entrepreneurship that they wish to start. Feasibility study of the chosen projects are carried out , discussed several times and once the preliminary framework is developed the school will hire different experts to guide the students through their initiatives. The school will avail the opportunity for the students to make presentations in front of potential investors. Upon acceptance of the project by the investor/s, the necessary formalities of registration and other documentation are completed to set the project into operation from the day of their graduation ceremony.



Other than the core differentiators Professional Entrepreneurship Groups (PEGs) and Managerial Skills Months (MSMs), the School has introduced following teaching methodologies:

## Scholarship

The School has provision of providing 50% scholarship on tuition fees to one student from each shift who scores highest marks in the pre-admission formalities. The pre-admission formalities include written test, group discussion and interview.
